***Show Management is required to collect \$30.00 inspection fee per

Padded horse per class; Flat Shod pleasure horses: management collects \$30.00 inspection fee per horse for its first class and then \$5.00 for each additional class for that same pleasure horse, per horse show on behalf of SHOW, Inc. Show HIO

Rider must have an Exhibitor Card (Trainer, Amateur, or Juvenile).

***There will be a one-time \$100 charge per horse, this includes 1 stall with 1 bag of shavings that must be reserved and paid for before April 10th. If you choose to not use a stall you must still pay the \$100 fee per horse that is brought onto the grounds.
