DIVISION DESCRIPTIONS

CLASSIC PARK-

Shoeing: A maximum ½" thick x 1 ½" wide hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum shoe.

LITE SHOD

Shoeing: A maximum $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick x 1" wide hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum shoe (both front and hind feet) with a maximum 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " turn back (measured from front to back of the caulk) is allowed.



CLASSIC LITE SHOD

Shoeing: A maximum of 3/8" thick x 3" wide with up to a 1/16" variance hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum shoe (both front and hind feet). Classic Lite Shod may show up in the Lite Shod and Classic Park classes at the same show.

TRAIL PLEASURE

Shoeing: A maximum of 3/8" thick x 3/4" wide with up to a 1/16" variance hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum shoe (both front and hind feet).

CLASSIC TRAIL PLEASURE

Shoeing: A maximum of 3/8" thick x 34" wide with up to a 1/16" variance hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum shoe (both front and hind feet)

The Classic Trail Pleasure may show in the Trail Pleasure classes at the same show.

COUNTRY PLEASURE

Shoeing: A factory stamped keg shoe (poured or cast) hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum light horse breed (non-draft breed) non toe weighted shoe is allowed. Poured or cast clips if poured in the original cast (may not be welded on). Poured or cast heels/caulks if poured in the original cast (may not be welded on).

CLASSIC COUNTRY PLEASURE

Shoeing: A factory stamped keg shoe (poured or cast) hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum light horse breed (non-draft breed) non toe weighted shoe is allowed. Poured or cast heels/caulks if poured in the original cast (may not be welded on).

*Classic Country Pleasure classes may show in the Country Pleasure classes at the same show.

ALL DAY PLEASURE

Shoeing: A maximum ½" thick x 1 inch wide shoe is allowed. This shoe must be in compliance with the Horse Protection Act (HPA).

CLASSIC ALL DAY PLEASURE

Shoeing: A factory stamped keg shoe (poured or cast) hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum light horse breed (non- draft breed) non toe weighted shoe is allowed. Poured or cast clips if poured in the original cast (may not be welded on). Poured or cast heels/caulks if poured in the original cast (may not be welded on)

*Classic All Day Pleasure may show up in the All Day Pleasure classes at the same show and in Halter, Showmanship, Equitation & Versatility at the same show.



- Photocopy of Horse Registration (front & back) required for all horses entered EXCEPT in All Day Pleasure & Versatility Classes.
- Current negative Coggins test (12 months) must be presented with initial entry.
- All exhibitors are required to hold a WHOA membership (\$60/\$20) WHOA
 Temporary Card (\$20) or NWHA membership. Available for purchase in show office.
- Formal Riding attire required.
