SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT U.S. EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.
- BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

 2. LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30.00 NON-MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES. 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION, 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.
- 3. THE HORSE SHOW EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to, the show, without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Committee; their decision is final. The Horse Show Executive Committee shall include the Chairman of the Horse Show Committee, the Competition Manager of the Monterey Springfest Horse Show, the Horse Show Secretary, the Director of the Foundation of the American Show Horse, and an Attorney.
- 4. ALL ENTRIES are accepted with the understanding that the Monterey Springfest Horse Show and the Monterey Fairgrounds and Exposition Center will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Horse Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Monterey Springfest Horse Show and the Monterey Fairgrounds against any and all loss, damage and liability thus occasioned including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of any entry form shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.
- Same of the provisions herein set forth.
 AMERICAN SADDLEBRED HORSES must be registered with the American Saddlebred Horse Association or the Canadian American Saddle Horse Registry. They must be entered in their full registered names with registration numbers and under the names of the owner(s) of record with the ASHA or the CASHA. A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership, or a copy of the registration papers with a Certificate of Eligibility to Show issued by the ASHA must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry. Exhibitors, trainers and owners must be a member of the USEF or pay a non-member fee. Trainers and owners must be current members in good standing with the American Saddlebred Ass'n. Copies of current membership cards are required.
- 6. HACKNEY PONIES must be registered with the American Hackney Horse Society and/or the Canadian Hackney Society. A copy of the pony's registration papers showing proof of ownership must be submitted with entry
- 7. ALL OWNERS AND EXHIBITORS WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE INCURRED BY THEM OR THEIR AGENTS TO BARNS OR OTHER MONTEREY COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS PROPERTIES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS AND WILL BE BILLED ACCORDINGLY. UPON ARRIVAL, PLEASE CHECK THE CONDITION OF YOUR STALLS AND REPORT DAMAGE TO MANAGEMENT AT ONCE TO AVOID YOUR PERSONAL FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY.

- 8. MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE OR ACCEPT CONDITIONALLY, OR TO CANCEL ANY ENTRIES, DISQUALIFY RIDERS OR EXHIBITORS, PROHIBIT EXHIBITION OF ENTRIES, CANCEL AWARD PRIZES, AND TO CANCEL, CONSOLIDATE OR SPLIT CLASSES WITHOUT CLAIM FOR DAMAGES.
- 9. IN ADDITION TO ENTRIES of persons suspended or expelled from the USEF, the Recognized competition may refuse any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of any agent, trainer, rider, driver or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude towards this Recognized competition or previous unsportsmanlike behavior at a Recognized competition or to its management.
- 10. ENTRIES CLOSE MARCH 26, 2014. ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER CLOSING DATE WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE ASSESSED A POST ENTRY FEE OF \$15.00 PER HORSE, UNLESS ORIGINAL ENTRY IS MADE AT THE SHOW, IN WHICH CASE THE POST ENTRY FEE PER HORSE SHALL BE \$25.00.
- 11. NUMBERS will not be released to exhibitors by the Horse Show Office until all entry blanks are complete, all necessary copies of registration papers, USEF membership cards and measurement cards or forms have been seen, and all fees have been paid. EXHIBITORS MUST ALSO PROVIDE AN OPEN CHECK TO COVER ANY EXPENSES THAT MIGHT BE INCURRED BY THEM DURING THE COURSE OF THE SHOW. ALL ACCOUNTS MUST BE CLOSED BY EXHIBITORS IN THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE END OF SHOW, OTHERWISE THE OFFICE WILL CLOSE ACCOUNTS APRIL 20th AT A FEE OF \$25.00 PER CHECK.
- 12. REFUNDS will be given if written notice is received by the Show Secretary before the closing of entries. Exhibitors scratching their horse for any reason AFTER the official closing date shall forfeit all entry, stall and association fees UNLESS a valid Veterinarian's or Doctor's certificate of disability for entered horse/rider is submitted to the Horse Show Secretary prior to the first event of the horse show, in which case a \$40.00 fee will be assessed. If illness or injury after the start of the show should prevent exhibitor's participation in the balance of entered classes, a refund of unused class fees will be made, less a \$40.00 office fee, providing the balance of classes are officially scratched and a doctor's certificate is provided within 48 hours of the close of the show. STALL AND ASSOCIATION FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.
- 13. ADDS & SCRATCHES. Any entry postmarked after the closing date will be assessed a fee of \$15 per horse. Any original entry made at the show will be assessed a fee of \$25 per horse. If classes are scratched through the horse show office after the closing date and prior to the start of the show, a fee of \$40 will be assessed and all other fees will be refunded. AN OPEN, SIGNED CHECK MUST BE ON FILE WITH THE SHOW SECRETARY TO COVER THESE ADDITIONAL FEES AND OTHER INCIDENTALS.
- 14. CHAMPIONSHIP STAKE ENTRIES. To be eligible, horses must be entered, shown, and judged in any class in the division. To be "shown and judged" in any class in which horses compete together, an animal must perform in all required gaits both ways of the ring in the original workout and must remain in the ring until excused by the judge.
- 15. USEF MEMBERSHIP. Every owner, trainer, rider, driver and handler competing in USEF-recognized divisions must present a current USEF membership card or copy thereof, or pay the \$30 non-member fee which is nonrefundable.
- 16. USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION. Every person who has reached his 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under USEF rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the USEF. This certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the Show Secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the USEF. Non-members of the USEF may not show in Amateur classes, in the absence of this certification.
- ALL RIDERS, DRIVERS, AND ATTENDANTS shall be neatly and suitably dressed on entering the show ring.
- 18. STABLING. STALLS WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM 8:00 AM ON TUESDAY, APRIL 15TH AND MUST BE VACATED NO LATER THAN NOON ON SUNDAY, APRIL 20th. NO FIRST BEDDING WILL BE FURNISHED. STALLS ARE 10' BY 10', PERMANENT AND PORTABLE. STALL DOORS ARE PROVIDED.
- 19. EARLY ARRIVALS. THE FAIRGROUNDS WILL ASSESS A FEE OF \$20 PER STALL, PER DAY FOR ANY ARRIVAL PRIOR TO TUESDAY, APRIL $15^{\rm TH}$.
- 20. The competition arena is 250' by 125'. The footing is a combination of sand and dirt.

- 21. PROTESTS. Please refer to GR 603 for complete rule.
- **22. PENALTY.** There will be a penalty of \$50.00 if a check is refused by the bank for any reason. No checks will be processed through the bank a second time, and must be covered by a money order, cashiers check or cash, in addition to the penalty.
- 23. PARKING. NO PARKING WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS. ONLY VEHICLES LOADING AND UNLOADING HORSES WILL BE ALLOWED ACCESS TO THE GROUNDS. PUBLIC PARKING IS AVAILABLE WITHIN ONE BLOCK OF THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE.
- 24. CAMPER AND RV PARKING will be available for exhibitors who order space on their entry blanks. Arrival date, exact dates of occupancy and length of camper must be declared. Spaces will be assigned.
- 25. DOGS AND ALL OTHER PETS must be on leashes at all times. No pets are allowed in the grandstand at any time. Exhibitors abusing the leash law will not be allowed to participate in the horse show and will be asked to leave the grounds. Stray dogs will be impounded and turned over to the Monterey SPCA.
- 26. MINORS who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 26. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- 27. PRIZE MONEY will be mailed within thirty days of the conclusion of the Horse Show.
- 28. SCRATCHES AND RIDER CHANGES: ALL SCRATCHES AND RIDER CHANGES MUST BE MADE IN THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE START OF EACH PERFORMANCE.
