OPEN: Indicates class is open to any rider, Amateur or Professional, or as age specified on class listing.

COUNTRY PLEASURE: stamped cast keg shoe only, NO Handmade Shoes **SPOTTED SADDLE HORSE PLEASURE:** Keg Shod, NO HEADSHAKE

TRAIL PLEASURE: 3/4" X 7/16" or less

LITE SHOD: 1/2" x 1"
OPEN SHOD: 1/2" x 1 1/2"

CLASSIC CLASS: NO TUNGSTEN SHOES allowed.. 1/2" X 1 1/2" or less

JUVENILE PERFORMANCE CLASS: 1/2" X 1 1/2" or less

LEAD LINE CLASS: All participants in Lead Line Class (riders age 6 and under) will receive a blue ribbon. Each participant at all shows will receive points equal to a first place tie. LEAD LINE CLASS WILL NOT BE JUDGED/TIED. All participants must pay an entry fee at all shows; **no prize money will be awarded**. Funds derived from entry fees (less DQP inspection fee) will accumulate in a Lead Line fund, to be used for year-end awards for all qualifying riders. All other Lead Line Class rules as found in the NSSHA Rule Book will apply. LEAD LINE CLASS WILL NOT BE JUDGED/TIED.

JUVENILE EQUITATION CLASS: Riders Age 17 and Under. Allows all types of NSSHA registered horses, gait will not reflect in judging. Riders to be judged on appearance, seat, hands and ability to control or show horse. Western hat or helmet required. No Stallions

AMATEURS: Age 18 and Older

JUVENILES: Age 11 and Under and Age 12 –17, Juveniles Age 12-17 may show in Amateur Classes but will receive Juvenile points toward Horse of the Year Award.

EXHIBITORS CARD: All Exhibitors, Age 7 and Older, Must own a current 2015 NSSHA

ENTRY DESK: Will be open each night at 5:00 pm. Entry forms to be completed by two classes prior to class you intend to show in. Anyone attempting to enter class after the entry sheets are turned in will be refused entry. **NO** Refunds on Entry Fees, **NO** Exceptions.

DQP: All Horses **must** enter DQP Station prior to entering Show Ring.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR ENTRIES: You are responsible for entering in the correct class(es). The National Spotted Saddle Horse Association, Inc. assumes no responsibility for making sure you are in the correct class.

GROUNDS FEES: All horses **MUST PAY** a grounds fee of \$12.00 per night, whether stall is used or not. The \$12.00 grounds fee per horse, per night, will be paid at the entry desk, along with your entry fees. This grounds fee will allow you use of a stall during the time of the show, but not overnight. Overnight stalls cost \$25.00 per night, per horse. Overnight Horse Trailers with campers in barn area, additional \$15.00 per night and in Camping Area \$25.00 per night.
