2. Wisconsin Law requires all out of state horse to have a valid health certificate (issued no earlier than 30 days prior.) All horses on show grounds are required to have a valid 12 month Coggins upon entry to the show grounds.
3. Any persons on Federal Disqualification CANNOT transport horses to this show and can only participate as a spectator.
4. Pads, plastic wrap, hoof bands and action devices are not allowed on show grounds.
