## Class Information, Rules and Regulations ALL NSSHA RULES WILL APPLY

ALL HORSES ENTERING IN THIS SHOW MUST BE NSSHA REGISTERED Exception: Solid Color Classes

(ALL OWNERS, TRAINERS and EXHIBITORS MUST BE CURRENT DUES PAYING NSSHA MEMBER. NO EXCEPTIONS.

#### **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. Horses must be registered to show at this show.
- 2. All Horses must have a negative Coggins.
- Exhibitors Card: Exhibitors must have or purchase a 2018 NSSHA Exhibitors or Trainers Card prior to showing at this show. Card may be purchased at the entry desk. Juvenile Cards for Exhibitors 7-17 and Amateur Cards for Exhibitors 18 and Older - \$15.00 Trainers Card for Trainers Age 18 and Older - \$50.00
- Country Pleasure Stamped Cast Keg Shoe, Spotted Saddle Horse Pleasure –3/4" X 7/16" or less - with NO HEADSHAKE, Trail Pleasure – 3/4" x 7/16" or less, Lite Shod – 1/2" x 1" or less, Open - 1/2" x 1 1/2" or less. Open Classes indicate Riders Age 12 and Older unless otherwise specified. Classic Class - NO Tungsten Shoes Allowed.
- Lead Line Class All participants in Lead Line Class (Riders Age 6 and Under) will receive a blue ribbon. Each participant at all shows will receive points equal to a first place tie. LEAD LINE CLASS WILL NOT BE JUDGED/TIED. Any participant accumulating 75 or more points will receive an award at the annual awards banquet. All participants must pay an entry fee at all shows. No prize money will be awarded.
- 6. Pleasure horses may cross enter in pleasure classes with qualifying shoe size. Performance Horses may cross enter in performance classes with qualifying shoe size.
- 7. Any Horse entering the wrong class will be dismissed or disqualified. The second offense of entering the wrong class will disqualify the horse and responsible party for the remainder of the show. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENTERING YOUR HORSE IN THE CORRECT CLASS.
- 8. Equitation classes allow all types of NSSHA registered horses. Gait will not reflect in judging. Riders to be judged on appearance, seat, hands and ability to control or show horse. Western hat or helmet required. No communication devices allowed.
- 9. Juveniles Age 12-17 Riding in Amateur Classes will receive Points toward Juvenile of the Year Award.
- 10. NSSHA or sponsoring organizations are not responsible for accidents, theft or liability of any type. Payment of your entry fee and/or admission fee acknowledges these rules.

#### "Persons on Federal Disqualification cannot transport horses to this show and can participate only as Spectators"

#### Blue Ribbon Wins at this Show can be calculated toward National Supreme Champion Awards. Contact NSSHA for forms.

Registrations will be accepted at Entry Desk, for Gaited Spotted Saddle Horses meeting NSSHA requirements as outlined in the Rule Book. Please call 615-890-2864 prior to show for details.

**Exhibitor Cards**: All Exhibitors must have or purchase a 2018 Exhibitors Card. Riders 6 and Under are not required to purchase a Card. Cards are available as follows: Juveniles: Age 7 - 17 • Card Fee \$15.00 Amateurs: Age 18 and Older • Card Fee \$15.00 Trainers: Age 18 and Older • Card Fee \$50.00. Cards may be purchased at the Entry Desk.

#### **NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED**

**Entry Forms:** All Entry Forms must contain the following information: Horse's Name and Reg #, Current Owners Name and Address, Exhibitors Name and Exhibitor Card #, Signature of Individual Responsible for the Entry (Trainer or Exhibitor) Any Entry Form not completed correctly will be not be accepted until correct.

Entries will be accepted each night for that night's show. Entry Desk will be open until the close of the Show. All Entries must be made at least 5 classes prior to the class you intend to enter. <u>NO</u> <u>EXCEPTIONS</u>. There will be no pre-entries accepted for this show, only on a nightly basis. If you would like to receive an Entry Form, prior to Show Date, please forward a <u>self-addressed stamped</u> envelope and

we will mail you one or you may download one from nssha.com website; this will allow you to complete your form prior to the show, if you wish.

#### NO REFUNDS ON ENTRY FEES YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENTERING INTO THE CORRECT CLASSES.

**DQP:** All horses must enter DQP Station for inspection prior to entering the show ring.

**GROUNDS/STALL FEES:** All horses entering into competition at this show must pay a \$15.00 per horse grounds fee, per night. The grounds fee allows you the use of a stall for that night's show. This fee will be accepted at the Entry Desk at time of Entry, your horse only pays one stall fee per night, no matter how many classes entered. Stall Fees are as follows: Use of Stall for the Show Night - \$15.00 each, Feed, Food or Tack Stalls - \$15.00 each. Overnight Stalls - \$25.00 per night. (bedding available though Tennessee Livestock Center, for additional fee)

**There will be absolutely no working out of trailers on front parking lot!** Trucks and Trailers bearing entries for show will be the only vehicles allowed in the Barn Area, with the exception of Show Officials. If your vehicle is carrying Show Clothing, Food, Etc., please pay your admission fee at the gate, get stamped for payment verification, unload your vehicle and return it to the front parking lot.

#### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Juvenile Classes: Age 11 and Under classes - Mares and Geldings ONLY NO STALLIONS. Age 17 and Under classes - Mares and Geldings ONLY, NO STALLIONS.

Age 12 – 17 Classes MAY show Mares, Stallions and Geldings.

**Amateur Classes:** Open to Amateur Riders Age 12 and Older and Juvenile Riders Age 12 and Older. **Open Classes:** Open to both Trainers and Amateurs, also, if class description allows, to riders age 12 and older. Please refer to class descriptions and Age of Exhibitor.

**Amateur Owned and Trained Classes:** Horse must <u>**not be**</u> professionally trained, trained by the owner, and owned by the exhibitor or his immediate family, horse must be out of a trainers barn for 30 days or more prior to the show.

**Qualifying for Championship Stake Class:** In order to enter any of the Championship Stake Classes you must complete your class, through the line-up and the judging, you cannot ask to be excused prior to end of Class. Horse must have qualified in a previous class to enter Championship Classes. You do not have to win or place in your preliminary class to enter into the Championship Classes. Some Classes may specify what Class you must have qualified in, please refer to your class sheet, if your Championship Stake Class is a Canter Class, your horse must qualify in a Canter Class.

# Effective August 13, 2017, the use of a flash shooting into any NSSHA horse show ring, indoors or outdoors, is PROHIBITED when a Professional photographer is in place at the show, and employed by the show.

All cameras or cell phones having the ability to capture horse show images, MUST have the flash DISABLED, when shooting photos of horses and/or riders, with the NSSHA show ring. Violators will be dealt with accordingly.

#### ENTRY FEES and PREMIUMS:

#### Qualifying Classes Entry Fee: \$20 Class 87 (Costume Class) Entry Fee: \$20

Paybacks in all classes will be on a percentage basis, except 66 and 67, prize money in each class will be determined by number of entries in each class, with 1<sup>st</sup> place receiving 50% of available entry fees in class, 2<sup>nd</sup>place receiving 30% of available entry fees in the class, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place receiving 20% of available entry fees in the class, ribbons for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>. (DQP fee is deducted from each entry fee, then 50% of remaining fee is reserved for prize money, and the other 50% goes toward the cost of the show.

Stick Horse – Class 66 – No Fee

ALL Juvenile Championships – Entry Fee: \$30.00 \*Exception Class 67 will receive no prize money; all will receive blue ribbons and awards. Paybacks will be on a percentage basis, with 1<sup>st</sup> place winners receiving floral horseshoe and trophy award

ALL Amateur and Open Championships – Entry Fee: \$40 (exception Class 96) Paybacks will be on a percentage basis, with 1<sup>st</sup> place winners receiving floral horseshoe and trophy award

> Class 96 - Entry Fee: \$50.00 Paybacks will be on a percentage basis, with 1<sup>st</sup> place winner receiving floral horseshoe, trophy award and trophy buckle

ADMISSION \$6.00 - Children 6 and Under Admitted FREE
