## Regulations

### ALL SSHBEA RULES APPLY IN ALL CLASSES

**\* ALL HORSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH SSHBEA & ALL HORSES MUST BE RECORDED IN THE CORRECT OWNERS NAME**

**\*ALL AMATEUR (RIDERS 18 YEARS & OVER) MUST HAVE A SSHBEA AMATEUR CARD**

**\*Exhibitors 17 & Under are required to have a Youth Card.**

**\*ALL TRAINERS (RIDERS 18 YEARS & OVER) MUST HAVE A PSSHTA (TRAINER) CARD**

**\*AMATEUR OWNED & TRAINED CLASSES** - One in which every contestant is either an "Amateur" who owns the entry being shown or is an amateur member of owner's immediate family. **Co-Ownership/exhibiting between two non-related amateurs is not allowed in this class.**

\*Dues must be paid in Ladies Auxiliary and Youth Council and all requirements must be met to show in these classes.

\*Men's and Ladies designated classes are for riders 18 years and over.

\*A negative coggins is required on all horses entering the show grounds.

**\*Trail Pleasure Shoeing:** A maximum of 3/8" thick x 3/4" wide with up to a 1/16" variance hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum shoe (both front and hind feet). Borium is allowed on the caulks and toes of the shoe, but the thickness of the shoe, caulk and borium must not exceed 7/8" in thickness. Maximum 1 1/2" turn back (measured from front to back of caulk). Clips are optional when drawn from the original steel, or poured. No Tungsten allowed

**\*Lite Shod Shoeing:** A maximum 1/2" thick x 1" wide hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum shoe (both front and hind feet) with a maximum 1 1/2" turn back (measured from front to back of the caulk) is allowed. Borium is allowed on the caulks and toes of the shoe, but the thickness of the shoe, caulk and borium must not exceed 1 1/8" thick. Clips are optional when drawn from the original steel or poured. No Tungsten allowed

**NO electronic devices allowed in any Amateur Owned & Trained classes (adult or youth)**

**All Classes will be required to back except 11 & under**

**WORKOUTS** – Rule 12.29 (page39) A workout must be held if there are 22 or more entries.

**SPLIT CLASSES** -- Rule 9.2 BB (page 26) To split classes in which entries total 35 or greater.

**Belt Buckles:** Will be presented in the 5 World Grand Championship classes. **If a person wins a preliminary or grand championship class, they may order a buckle after the fall show by contacting the SSHBEA office by October 15.**

**\*Open Shod Shoeing:** A maximum 1/2" thick x 1 1/2" wide hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum shoe. Borium is allowed on the caulks and toes of the shoe. The thickness of the shoe, caulk and borium together must not exceed 1 1/8" thick. A maximum 1 5/8" turn back (measured from the front to the back of the caulk) is allowed. Clips are optional when drawn from the original steel or poured. No Tungsten allowed

**\*Spotted Pleasure & Country Pleasure** – Manufactured, stamped, cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8" thick x 3/4" wide. The length of the toe must not exceed 4". No welded caulks allowed. Bands allowed / No tungsten allowed (**name changed and approved Feb. 12, 2018**)

\*All Trail Pleasure divisions and Lite Shod horses are eligible to show in Open Classes.

\*Anyone working out of a Trailer will be charged

\*N/C – indicates NO CANTER - Canter – indicates WILL CANTER

\*Classes designated 17 & Under, no stallions are permitted.

\*Classes designated 11 & Under, no stallions are permitted.

\*Classes designated 12-17, **stallions are permitted.**

\*Children 11 & Under cannot show in classes where stallions are permitted to show.

\*Amateur Owned & Trained must not have been professionally trained within the last 90 days.

NOVICE CLASSES – Horses must not have ever won a blue ribbon at a fall show.

**Show Personnel is responsible for enforcing the SSHBEA rules and USDA's required rules. Knowledge of the SSHBEA Rule Book will hopefully help you have an enjoyable show. It is encouraged that you are familiar with the SSHBEA Rule Book and any addendums. Exhibitors are encouraged to read the following rules:**

29.8 – No pads allowed. Exception: Corrective shoeing with a wedge and artificial hoof material shall be allowed in the show ring when applied to one hoof only, for the purpose of mending a broken hoof or hoof wall. Mended hoof must match natural hoof and the sole of the hoof must be visible.

### GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

QUALIFYING GUIDELINES FOR GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: A HORSE SHOWING IN A 2 GAIT GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS MUST QUALIFY IN ANY 2 GAIT PRELIMINARY CLASS. A HORSE SHOWING IN A 3 GAIT GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS MUST QUALIFY IN ANY 3 GAIT PRELIMINARY CLASS.

*Admission \$5  
Children Under 6 Free*

*\$20 per horse/per day ground fee---  
Exception: No grounds fee charged if stalls are rented for each horse(all to be collected at entry office).*

*If trailer is plugged into electricity there will be a \$25 per night charge*

*Exhibitors working out of Trailer will be charged a \$20 fee and will park in designated Parking in the Grass Area.*

*Stalls/Tack \$20 per stall/tack per night*

*R.V Sites \$40 plus tax per night (Please Pay at Entry Office)*
