For all other classes, \$5.00 of each entry fee will be added to a jackpot for the class winner.

Owner and Exhibitor must be a PWHAT member and horse must show in same class at a minimum of 2 shows in order for points to count for year-end high-point awards. In case of a high-point tie, horse that showed at most shows wins the award.

ADP open to all gaited breeds/Amateur exhibitors only. "Flat shod" classes open to all flat shod shoeing divisions. Unless otherwise specified, all Classes are 2 gait and may be shown English or Western
