Racking classes-26 and 36 are for SSHBEA registered horses only and must show in Western tack & attire.

Racking classes-23 and 46 are for spotted or solid horses and English or Western tack & attire are acceptable.

Negative Coggins REQUIRED. All horses MUST be checked by the DQP.

Admission: \$5; Trailer driver will be admitted free, but all others in vehicle must pay admission.

Entry fees: Class 1-\$0, Class 5-\$15, All Other Classes-\$25.00

Awards: Class 1-Ribbons & Medallions, Class 5-Ribbons & Trophies, All Other Classes: Ribbons 1st-5th and payback as follows: 1st-\$25, 2nd-\$20 and 3rd-\$15, Special Customized Award for Best of Show Winner

AMATEUR OWNED & TRAINED MUST NOT have been professionally trained within the last 90 days, and is either the amateur contestant who owns the entry being shown or is an amateur member of the owner's immediate family.

SPOTTED PLEASURE-manufactured stamped cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8 x 3/4 inch and toe must NOT exceed 4 1/2 inches. Head Shake NOT allowed. **COUNTRY PLEASURE**-manufactured stamped cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8 x 3/4 inch and toe must NOT exceed 4 1/2 inches. Head Shake Allowed. **TRAIL PLEASURE**-shoe may NOT exceed 3/4 x 7/16 inch thick. Caulk CANNOT exceed 1 inch, measured from turn back. **SSH TRAIL PLEASURE RACKING**-shoe may not exceed 3/4 x 3/8 inch.

SSH COUNTRY PLEASURE RACKING-any size shoe up to the plantation shoe (1 1/2 x 1/2 inch)

Lite Shod-shoe may not exceed 1/2 inch thick x 1 inch wide – NO Double Caulks - NO TUNGSTEN. **OPEN SHOD**-shoe may not exceed 1/2 inch thick x 1 1/2 inch wide – DOUBLE CAULKS ALLOWED, caulks must not exceed 1 3/4 inch and must be a turn back S-caulk - No welding - No blocks - NO TUNGSTEN.
