- 1. Horses must be registered to show at this show.
- 2. All Horses must have negative Coggin
- Exhibitors Card: Exhibitors must own or purchase a 2024 NSSHA Exhibitors or Trainers Card prior to show at this show. Card may be purchased at the Entry Desk. Juveniles Cards for Exhibitors 7-17 and Amateur Cards for Exhibitors 18 and Older -\$15.00. Trainers Card - \$25.
- 4. Spotted Saddle Horse Pleasure 3/8" x 3/4", NO Headshake, Country Pleasure –, stamped cast keg shoe. Trail Pleasure 3/8" 3/4", Performance Classes: Lite Shod 1/2" x 1", Open 1/2" x 1" 1/2 ". Open Classes indicate riders. Age 12 and Older unless otherwise specified. Classic Performance Class 1/2" x 1 1/2" NO Tungsten Shoes Allowed. Juvenile Performance Class 1/2" x 1 1/2" or less.
- 5. Juveniles Age 12-17 Riding in Amateur Classes will receive Points toward Juvenile of the Year Award.
- 6. \*\*2 Year old Open Shod Incentive: This class is open to all 2 Year Old Open Shod entries; if you want to joining the incentive, and extra \$25 will be charged, in addition to the normal entry fee; the additional \$25 goes into the inventive fund. If you do not join the inventive program initially, but wish to join later, you will be required to (catch up) your incentive fees, for all 2024 shows, prior to joining. Incentive payment will be made at the NSSHA 45<sup>th</sup> Annual World Grand Championship Show.
- 7. NSSHA or sponsoring organization is not responsible for accidents, theft or liability of any type. Payment of your entry fee and/or admission fee acknowledges these rules.
- 8. \*Persons on Federal Disqualification cannot transport horses to this show and can participate only as Spectators.
