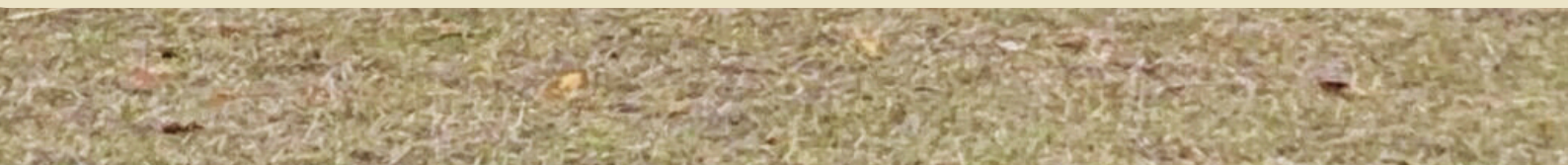

Registration Requirements

Horses must be registered with NAPHA or the PHAC. Horses must be entered as shown on registration papers, horse name & number and registered owner.

Male horses 4 years of age must be registered as a stallion or gelding. Horses registered as “male” can only be shown in Colts 3-4 in Bozal class. Spayed mares may not be shown as a breeding mare.

Important Requirement!

NAPHA Membership is now required for all persons who will be presenting or riding horses in the show. Riders not listed, as 2026 members will not be allowed to enter the arena.

You can renew your membership by visiting napha.net and clicking on Join NAPHA.

Forms will be available at the show. If presenters/riders do not own a NAPHA registered horse, they can join for \$50 annually as an aficionado member, membership applications MUST be signed in show office.

Reminder - All Sponsorships and Ads must be paid no later than March 1st.

FUNDS AND FINANCES

Funds: All payments must be in U.S. Funds either in Cash, Approved Checks or Credit Card. All Prize money will be awarded in U.S. funds by check. Any refunds are given also in U.S. funds.

Payment Policy: We cannot extend credit of any kind to anyone, NO EXCEPTIONS. All entries must be paid in full by cash, a good check, credit card (3% charge added), money order or cashier's check at the time the entry is submitted. Any entry received without proper payment and/or copies of current registration papers, or coggins receipts, will be considered incomplete and may be subject to late fees. If an exhibitor desires to add classes, horses, shavings, or any other expense during the show, these additional charges must be paid for at that time, or the Show Secretary must be given a signed, currently dated, open check to be used for show related expenses.

Outstanding Debts: Anyone owing a debt 60 days past due from the date of the first billing to NAPHA or one of its approved shows may not be allowed to show in a NAPHA approved show in any capacity, including owner, trainer, rider, handler, etc. Any exhibitor who owes an outstanding debt to NAPHA for any reason will not be allowed to exhibit his/her horses until the unpaid balance is satisfied.

Late Fee: A late fee of \$30.00 per horse will be assessed on any horse entered after March 28th, 2026. This fee will also be assessed on each horse on entries that remain incomplete after March 28th (those without copies of registration papers or full payment) regardless of when the entry was received.

Substitution: If a horse is entered by March 28th, but then is unable to perform, another horse may be substituted at no additional fee.

Refunds: All request for refunds must be submitted to the Horse Show Office by 12 PM on Sunday May 3rd , the last day of the horse show.

Absolutely no request will be considered after this date. No EXCEPTIONS. Valid, written veterinary excuse is required. ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE WITHOUT A WRITTEN VETERINARY EXCUSE. For pre -entered horses not shown: class fees, stall fees are refundable. For horses at the show: refunds ONLY FOR PRE-ENTERD CLASSES. If a horse is disqualified from showing by the Show Management or Officials, or if a horse is entered and not shown, all fees will be forfeited.

Regular class Refunds: Refunds will only be considered only due to injury or illness of a horse or exhibitor. Refund request must be accompanied by a veterinarian's or doctors' statement.

In all instances, there will be no refund of the office fee and security fee.

FACILITY RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Alcohol: No Outside alcohol may be brought into the horse show facility. If it is determined that alcohol has been brought in the facility from an outside source, the parties may be subject to a fine.

Dog Rule: ALL dogs must be on a leash and muzzled at all times when on the show grounds. Absolutely NO dogs are allowed in the ARENA OR VENDOR AREA. Dogs running free will be removed by animal control. Owners of loose animals may be fined.

Parking: There will be absolutely no parking in unauthorized barn areas. Parking will be allowed for loading and unloading only. Parking will be in designated areas only.

Horse/Washing: Do not wash horses in barn area. Please use the wash racks. Please do not let your hoses leak into the barn area to create puddles.

Responsibility: Entries are accepted with the understanding that this Show committee, NAPHA, and the World Equestrian Center, will not be held responsible for any loss of any kind, personal injury, or damage to horses exhibited, for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the show committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person or animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the management against all claims or damages of any kind or nature including attorney fees and court costs, that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him or arising from any cause whatever, including the negligence of himself or any other person, including the person in charge of any such horse.

Show Rules & Regulations: Everything is being done to conduct this show on the highest possible level and for the pleasure and safety of exhibitors and spectators. The best adjudication officials to be found have been selected and they will place awards to the horses as they see them presented in the ring without regard for previous records or performances. The Peruvian Horse Sunshine Show is desirous of fair treatment for all exhibitors.

Feed & Bedding

Initial order of shavings and hay must be placed on the WEC website, a minimum of 4 bags per stall is required. It is recommended to place your order at least 1 week before arrival.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS AND STABLING INFORMATION

IMPORTANT!

All horses must have a Health Certificate issued by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days of the show.

All Horses including Florida over the age of 6 months must have proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) test within 12 months of the show and vaccination record. PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY LAST MINUTE REQUIREMENTS ON HORSES ENTERING THE STATE OF FLORIDA. YOU MUST STOP AT THE FIRST FLORIDA DEPARTMENT INSPECTION STATION, AS YOU ENTER FLORIDA. DO NOT STOP AT A FLORIDA DEPT. OF TRANSPORTATION STATION. THERE ARE SIGNS AS YOU ENTER THE STATE SAYING YOU MUST ENTER THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE INSPECTION STATION. IF YOU DO NOT STOP YOU ARE LIABLE FOR A \$1000.00 FINE.

Exhibitors must show their veterinary papers to the Barn Manager or Security BEFORE unloading their horses. Any exhibitor arriving without the required veterinary papers will not be permitted to unload.

Please contact Maria (Nena) Castillo (305) 803-2791 for stall assignments. Please order your shavings and hay on the WEC website. Any additional shavings must be bought by the participant. Make sure you bring everything you need for the comfort of your horses in the stalls. Keep all aisles clean and clear, no obstructions.

Conduct and Safety: This show expects the highest standard of ethics from its exhibitors and those persons under their authority and will tolerate no act of disobedience or discourtesy toward any show official, under penalty of disqualification or expulsion from the show. Courtesy toward fellow exhibitors and the viewing public is compulsory at all times. Cruelty to any horse, by any person, at this show will NOT be tolerated.

Exhibitors shall at all times take whatever steps are necessary to protect themselves, their horses, and the viewing public.

Responsibility: Entries are accepted with the understanding that this Show committee, NAPHA, and the World Equestrian Center, will not be held responsible for any loss of any kind, personal injury, or damage to horses exhibited, for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. SHOW RULES AND SPECIAL CLASS INFORMATION

Show Rules & Regulations: Everything is being done to conduct this show on the highest possible level and for the pleasure and safety of exhibitors and spectators. The best adjudication officials to be found have been selected and they will place awards to the horses as they see them presented in the ring without regard for previous records or performances. The Peruvian Horse Sunshine Show is desirous of fair treatment for all exhibitors.

Champion of Champions from the NAPHA US Nationals may enter directly to their respective Champion of Champions class. They must be pre- entered by April 1st , 2025. This does not apply to Best Bozal or Best Gaited championships.

IMPORTANT - NEW - Champion & Reserve Champion's; Champion of Champions Breeding/Luxury Classes: Returning Champion of Champions and any horse that has qualified for the Champion & Reserve, Breeding Mare or Breeding stallion classes **MUST ENTER** their respective Zootecnico class on Sunday morning, prior to the championships.

Championship and Champion of Champions Classes:

1st and 2nd place of qualifying classes will be automatically entered into the appropriate Best or Champion; Reserve classes; if the qualifying class allows more than one sex of horse, the 1st and 2nd place winners will be entered into the class of the appropriate sex, if applicable. It is not required that a 1st or 2nd place horse enter a Best of or Champion and Reserve Class. Best of or Champion and Reserve classes all have an associated fee. If a horse will not enter its Best or Champion/Reserve Class, and the Show Secretary is notified at least one hour before the class, then a refund will be credited for the Best or Champion/ Reserve Class fee.

This show's Champions will be automatically entered into their respective Champion of Champions Classes as long as they competed in their respective Zootecnico class Sunday morning.

Novice Equitation Performance M/S/G 18+: to be judged 100% on the rider's equitation, requiring performance-style maneuvers.

Ranch or Breeder's Conjunto - Bit/Bozal; entry is restricted to three horses only. Horses must be owned or bred by the same person or ranch.

PLEASE NOTE:

If a tack change is required, you must sign a request and give it to the show secretary at least 3 classes in advance of the class where you need the tack change. A tack change adds 4 minutes to the 3-minute class call open gate, making a total of 7 minutes for a tack change. If any exhibitor is not familiar with the way the classes are run, PLEASE ask one of our officials for assistance. We would be very happy to assist you in any way we can.

JUDGING GUIDELINES

Judges will use current NAPHA rules to arrive at their decision.

Gait Division to be judged 100% on Gait.

Conformation Division to be judged 100% on Conformation.

Breeding Division

to be judged 41% Gait, 27% Conformation, 27% Brio & Temperament, 5% Condition

Bozal Division

to be judged 40% Gait, 35% Conformation, 30% Brio & Temperament, 5% Condition

Halter Division

to be judged 30% Gait, 45% Conformation, 20% Brio & Temperament,
5% Condition

Performance Division

to be judged 50% on Performance, Brio, Suitability & Manners, 40% Gait, 45% and
10% Condition

The Elements of Gait are: Function, Smoothness, Elasticity and Ornaments

Function is the Refinement of Gait, Efficiency or Quality of Gait, Harmony and Cadence.

Smoothness is the absence of vertical movement with quiet hock action as long as it does not stem from weakness.

Elasticity is a horse's ability to execute a perfect gait at different speeds. At the same Quality of Gait, the faster horse is better. But at Judge's discretion Quality of Gait may count more than speed. Having better quality of gait, the horse that increases the length of his stride to gain speed, and less quality of gait the horse that increases the number of steps to gain speed.

Ornaments is the combination of Termino, Lift and Extension

In all divisions the best horse is the one with the highest average of all attributes not the horse that excels at one.

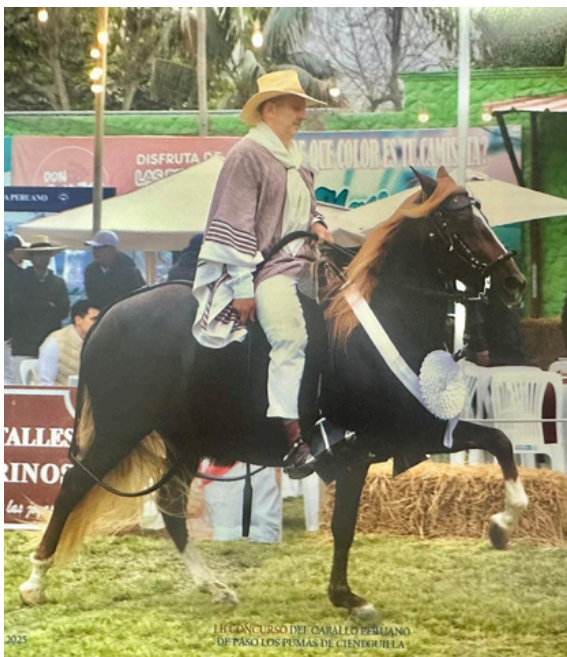
