Standard Entry Fee: \$15.00 per entry.

Inspection Fee: \$15.00 per horse, per gaited class entry.

Rider's Cup Class Fee (Classes 10, 14, 26, 28, 29, 33, 35): Standard Entry + Inspection + Additional \$10.00 fee.

Class 1 (Stick Horse): \$5.00 entry fee total. (Exempt from inspection fee)

Class 18 (Dollar Bareback): Requires physical \$1.00 bill brought to ring. Standard entry/inspection fees apply at registration.

The sponsoring organization and show management will not be responsible for any accidents or theft. Management reserves the right to change the order of classes, and to cancel any class if entries are not adequate. A minimum of three (3) entries from separate exhibitors must enter the ring to pay cash premiums; classes failing to meet minimum entries will compete for ribbons and honor only. No refunds will be made for admission or class cancellation after the show has started. A current negative Coggins Test is strictly required for all horses on show grounds. Any horse turned down by the inspector will forfeit entry fee. Inspector decisions are final. Persons on federal disqualification cannot transport horses to this show and can participate only as a spectator. Show management must collect inspection fees on behalf of the governing HIO as mandated by the Horse Protection Act.
