- HID rules will prevail.
- All class entry sheets must contain required information before a DGP will inspect an entry.
- GOOF CARTS, 3WHEELERS and 4WHEELERS. Operators must possess a valid driver's license. Children under 16 are not to operate golf carts, 3-wheelers or 4-wheelers. Law enforcement will be patrolling the grounds.
- The Majority Opinion Judge System will be used.
- Management reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry fee without being liable for compensation.
- The sponsoring organization and show management will not be responsible for any accident, injury or theft.
- EXHIBITOR PASSES – 2 per horse. General admission - \$5 per night, children 6 & Under – free.
- All classes will be split into an A and B division at the discretion of the show committee. Championship classes will not be split.
- Horses must have qualified by being entered, shown, and judged in at least one appropriate qualifying class. NOTE: Class #24, Trainers' Family Class & Class #15, PRO/AM Class, do not qualify for any championship class.
- OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP – no qualifying required. Championship classes will not split.
- No refund on horses that do not pass post-show inspection. Any scratches must be made on the day of performance.
- SIGNED CHECKS must be left in the office in order to run tabs.
- All horses must be accompanied by a current negative Coggins Certificate (EIA), which must have been issued within twelve (12) months.
- Persons on FEDERAL DISQUALIFICATION cannot transport horses to this show and can participate only as a spectator.
